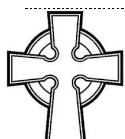


RELIGIOUS ARTICLE SALE Wed Nov, 28  
Volunteer sign-ups will be posted in the main entrance. Thank you Tarah and Elaine for getting everything ready and heading up this annual event.

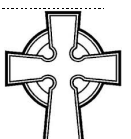


Please note change on **Jan 21, 2018**. Preschool will be open until 11am, but all daycare & school staff will be attending a school safety training that afternoon.

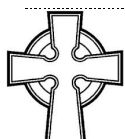
